Social care is under increasing financial pressure - **65%** of directors of adult social services say that some providers in their area have been forced to close in the past six months.



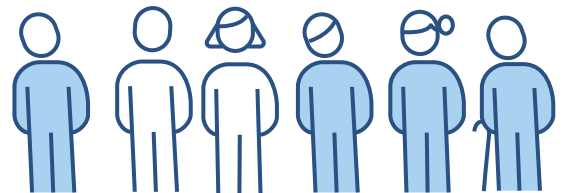
Only three in ten directors have confidence they can meet the £941m savings required by councils

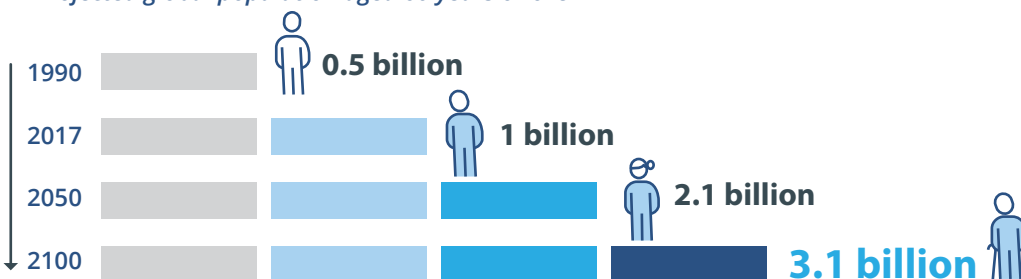
