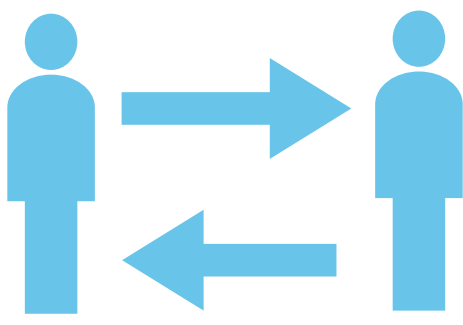
## 1 Create a positive workplace

If you notice that an employee is under-performing, it's important to find the root of the problem, rather than jump to conclusions.

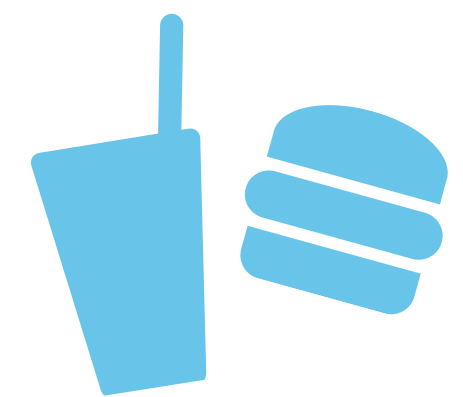


## 5 Boost customer service skills
