E nable LMS vs Open Source Platforms



Enable is a secure, cloud-based Learning Management System developed by Virtual College - one of the leading providers of e-learning in the UK.

There are many reports into the similarities and differences between open source learning platforms and a proprietary LMS like Enable. Cost and flexibility are often highlighted as the key advantages of an open source LMS. Reliability and support as the big advantages of a proprietary LMS.

Some Enable customers started with an open source LMS only to switch because of rising costs and frustration over customisation. Free does not always mean trouble free!

Many of the comparisons made also apply to out-of-the-box vendor solutions that are based on open source code.

Upgrades and new functionality

Flexibility

Enable LMS

- Two planned and managed upgrades per year.
- Continual commitment to R&D and LMS development.
- Changes configured to meet business needs.
- Client led innovation.
- Client feedback informs upgrade plans and new developments.

- Will develop custom functionality for customers.
- Enable comes configured, tested, and branded.

Open Source LMS

• No upgrade cycle.

Open source upgrades are either:

- 1. In house built solutions need ongoing investment and someone with a strong grasp of the software.
- 2. Externally sourced developers or users may make changes available to the community, but quality often can be an issue leading to more complex problems.
- Technology-focused and not learning led upgrades.
- To build your required functionality, complex bespoke coding will be needed.
- Design work will be needed to tailor the look and feel of the LMS to your organisation.



Bug fixes / security

Ongoing cost

- Enable LMS
- Included in service level agreement (SLA).
- Bug fixes rolled out to customers at no extra cost.
- Quick response to security threats.
- Updates kept up-to-date for all customers.

 Enable's cost is predictable since LMS support, maintenance and upgrades are often included in the fee.

Open Source LMS

- Increased costs and downtime when there is a problem.
- Must rely on availability, quality and speed of execution by third-party resources and/or online community.
- Expected to feed back to the community if you fix a bug or make an improvement.
 - Onus on you to keep abreast of security threats and ensure your LMS version and plugins are up-to-date.
- Repair/upgrade costs vary depending on severity and on the availability of skilled, external resources.



Hosting and implementation

Open Source LMS

- Must make your own hosting and support arrangements.
- Cost of hosting (server lease or purchase) alongside staff and support costs.
- Some information is provided for installation, but it is mostly 'DIY' and that's a risk (especially if the in-house guru leaves).
- May need to hire third-party resources. Can be 'here today gone tomorrow' with no long term commitment.



LMS support

Enable LMS

- Support costs shared across multiple customers.
- Immediate troubleshooting support to keep your LMS up and running, included in Service Level Agreement (SLA).
- Support documentation provided.
- No charge for LMS updates.

Open Source LMS

When the service is outsourced:

- Extra costs for support resources.
- Quality and control issues....speed of response.
- Extra costs for updates and patches.

When the service is in-house:

- Ongoing costs of staff and training to ensure they remain compliant and up to date.
- Relying on own system knowledge for integrations and database updates can lead to issues and costs.

When relying on the open source community for support:

• It can be difficult to find timely community-based support on a specific issue. You also need to know the right questions to ask.

Learner support

- Technical support included.
- First line learner support included.
- Reliant on internal IT resources or external LMS partner for technical support.
- Reliant on knowledge of online community.
- First line learner support often lacking.
- IT are not usually interested in supporting Learning & Development.
